Medical record documentation is required to record pertinent facts, findings, and observations about an individual's health history including past and present illnesses, examinations, tests, treatments, and outcomes.

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### 1995 DOCUMENTATION GUIDELINES FOR EVALUATION & MANAGEMENT ...

The 1995 and 1997 E/M guidelines are identical when it comes to the key component of Medical Decision-Making . That is to say, both versions are equally vague on the subject. At E/M University, we recommend using the much more precise Medical Decision-Making Point System .

### E/M DOCUMENTATION AUDITORS' WORKSHEET 1995 Guidelines

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CMS now allows for history of present illness (HPI) criteria that were limited to the 1997 Guidelines to be used for when determining the evaluation and management (E/M) level of service when using the 1995 Guidelines. This is a significant change that could result in significantly higher E/M levels for many providers.

E/M Components History: History of Present Illness History: Review of Systems History: Past, Family and Social Exam Decision Making; 1995: No Difference - An extended History of Present Illness may consist of status of three chronic/inactive conditions for either set of guidelines (1995 or 1997) for services performed on/after 09/10/13.

There are two sets of E/M guidelines: 1995 and 1997. The main difference between the 1995 and 1997 guidelines is the examination component. The 1995 guidelines allow more latitude for a detailed...

### **Coding for Evaluation and Management Services -- Physician ...**

The first audit of those codes showed such high error rates that CMS (then the Health Care Financing Administration) released the 1995 Documentation Guidelines for Evaluation and Management Services to quantify the information needed for each key component (i.e., history, examination, and medical decision-making).

### **Understand how to apply the 1995 and 1997 Documentation ...**

When billing Medicare, a provider may use either the 1995 or 1997 Documentation Guidelines for Evaluation and Management Services to document their choice of evaluation and management (E/M) CPT or HCPCS Level II code.

### **When To Use Both '95 and '97 Documentation Guidelines ...**

The 1997 guidelines were an enhancement to the 1995 guidelines to include status of chronic conditions, one general multisystem exam scorecard and 11 single organ system exam scorecards. The other components remained unchanged. These guidelines were developed by the American

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Medical Association (AMA), CMS, and various specialty societies.

### **Guidelines for the Evaluation and Management of Heart ...**

In 1995, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) published its first set of Documentation Guidelines for Evaluation and Management (E/M) Services. These guidelines expanded the CPT® E/M guidelines and attempted to make the code assignment criteria more objective and quantifiable.
