Install a choke system. Engine backfires when warm. Install a larger accelerator pump. Check for a lean fuel condition (carb too small, too small primary or secondary jet size or check for restricted fuel filter(s) or fuel lines). Check for vacuum leaks. Use a socket or nut driver to remove the two bolts that hold the carburetor to the engine. Then unhook the throttle cable from the carburetor linkage. Next, remove the carburetor from the engine (Photo 2). Place it in a container (to catch the gas) and open the carburetor bowl to check for corrosion (Photo 3).

Crank and run the engine until the fuel bowl runs dry. Turn off the engine and connect the fuel line. Then re-start and run engine. This will often flush dirt past the carburetor float needle and seat. (2) If dirt is in the fuel system, clean the system and replace filter (s) as necessary.

Reset the Walbro Carburetor to Default Settings For Walbro Carburetor Troubleshooting, a good place to start is with the "default" settings. To do this, tighten both screws all the way in (don't apply a lot of torque, just enough) then back them out 1½ full turns. At this point, the engine should start and run, although it may not run well.

In this guide I'll cover the main problems with small engine carburetors and the solutions. So how do you troubleshooting a small engine carburettor? The most common issue with all small engine carburetors is gumming (old gas), cleaning the carb usually solves the problem. Typical carburettor related problems include:

Small Engine Carburetor Troubleshooting | Lawnmowerfixed

It is a safety hazard and may cause a fire as fuel overflows out of the carburetor on to a hot engine. The fuel bowl within the carburetor has a float inside; this may also cause flooding if the bowl has a leak or the float is set too high. All you need to do is to replace the float.

Carburetor Troubleshooting | The Boat Galley

Pumping the gas a couple times can also start the engine, since the carburetor has an accelerator pump. However, it's easy to flood the engine this way. Move the throttle by hand just a little and see if the choke snaps closed. It should go all the way closed, or the rod is bent or the spring is maladjusted.

Troubleshooting a Quadrajets Carburetor | It Still Runs

Replace any fuel filters - There is usually one in the fuel inlet of the carburetor and often there will be an in-line fuel filter.
Vacuum leak - Use spray carburetor cleaner and spray around the base of the carburetor and any vacuum lines. If the RPM smooths out, then you found the problem. There could also be a leak at the intake manifold.
