Create an environment variable called JBOSS\_HOME that points to the JBoss Application Server installation directory, for example: C:\Program Files\JBoss\jboss-<release>. In order to run JBoss Application Server from the command line, add the jboss-<release>\bin directory to your path, for example: C:\Program Files\JBoss\jboss-<release>\bin .

### JBoss Application Server

After you have the binary archive you want to install, use the JDK jar tool (or any other ZIP extraction tool) to extract the jboss-4.0.1.zip archive contents into a location of your choice. The jboss-4.0.1.tgz archive is a gzipped tar file that requires a gnutar compatible tar which can handle the long pathnames in the archive.
