Some flexible staffing approaches, such as the use of agency staff, can be expensive and trusts are looking at options to reduce their temporary staffing costs (NHS Improvement, 2016b). Furthermore, there are some safety concerns related to the use of temporary staff, which can disrupt continuity of care and team communication (Aiken et al, 2007).

Reducing agency spend. Agency spend has been a focus since 2016 and in 2017, NHS Employers worked with 13 NHS trusts and an STP to focus on reducing their medical locum spend, make effective use of e-rostering software and maximise flexible working opportunities for staff. As a part of the QIPP challenge, NHS Trusts have been tasked with reducing the amount spent on agency and temporary staff by £300m by the end of the 2013/ 14 financial year. This represents a substantial challenge given that between 2007/8 and 2008/9 agency costs grew by around 50% to reach just short of £1.3 billion.

REDUCING AGENCY USE IN THE NHS

We introduced the agency rules in April 2016 to support trusts to reduce their agency expenditure and move towards a more sustainable level of temporary staffing. Since then, trusts have successfully reduced agency spend by over £1 billion. It has fallen from 8.2% of total the pay bill at its peak to just 4.4%. 3.

Reducing reliance on agency staff: consultation response

That percentage has now reduced dramatically to just 24% of respondents. The report found that fewer employers planed to reduce the amount of agency labour they would use and 34% of respondents were still paying agency workers less than comparable employees.

Rules for all agency staff working in the NHS - GOV.UK

Allow staff to adjust their approach to help prevent hostile or dangerous situations. Staff did not use prevention or de-escalation techniques. Retrain staff on how to prevent triggering people in care and use de-escalation techniques. Staff engaging in behaviors like verbal antagonism, which results in increased likelihood of usage of a restraint.

Postpone or stop all nonessential functions and reassign those staff to critical functions. If staffing continues to be a challenge, defer other lower priority functions. Focus staff time on core clinical duties (conserve). Minimize meetings and relieve staff of administrative responsibilities not related to incident.
